L'Istituto Patristico Augustinianum (Roma), per incarico della Curia generalizia dell'Ordine di s. Agostino, in occasione del XVI centenario della conversione di Agostino d'Ipbona, organizza un congresso internazionale di studi agostiniani.

L'iniziativa, oltre a fare il punto sugli studi sviluppatisi dal 1954 in poi (XV centenario della nascita di Agostino), intende favorire la ricerca e la riflessione scientifica su s. Agostino e il suo influsso.

Il tema generale è: **Agostino e la sua eredità, ieri e oggi.**

The Augustinian General Curia in Rome has authorized the Patristic Institute Augustinianum to organize an international congress of Augustinian studies on the occasion of the 16th Centenary of the conversion of St. Augustine of Hippo in 386.

This congress, whose general theme is: **Augustine and his heritage, yesterday and today**, has as its main purpose a review of Augustinian studies since 1954 (the date of the last international congress), and the furthering of scholarly research and thought on this great Church Doctor and his influence. All scholars are invited to take part.
